TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. This tournament is CTF sanctioned and all tournament and playing rules will be strictly enforced.
- 2. To enter this tournament ALL BOWLERS must be current members of the Greater Toronto Tenpin Bowling Association. Youth bowlers participating in Youth Leagues will not be permitted to bowl in this tournament. Non members living within the jurisdiction of this Association, who are not members of another association, may enter by paying the membership fee of \$33.00. A current membership card for each bowler must be shown when registering or current dues will be collected. A non-resident who is eligible for the association tournament in his association of residency may participate in this Association Championship Tournament provided she has bowled a minimum of 21 games in this Association as of December 1, 2025.
- 3. **This is a HANDICAP TOURNAMENT.** Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference between a bowler's average and 230. We have no negative handicaps.
- 4. New 600 Club (women) & 700 Club (men & women) Tournament Optional Scratch Tournaments using only the Doubles & Singles scratch scores bowled in the Handicap Tournament. The prize money collected for the 600 Club & 700 Club optional will be returned 100% on a ratio of 1 in 7 or major fraction thereof. Women can bowl in the 600 Club or the 700 Club but not in both tournaments.
- 5. All bowlers will use their highest sanctioned league average based on a minimum of 21 games for the 2024-2025 season. Anyone without a 2024-2025 average will use their highest 2025-2026 sanctioned league average for 21 games or more as of December 1, 2025. If the bowler has no average as per the foregoing she may use a sanctioned summer league average (21 or more games) for 2025. All other entrants will bowl scratch (230). *CTF RULES 319a-2 & a-3 ARE IN EFFECT WHEN THE PREVIOUS SEASON'S AVERAGE IS USED AND AS OF DECEMBER 1, 2025, AN ENTRANT HAS A CURRENT AVERAGE FOR 21 OR MORE GAMES THAT IS 10 PINS OR MORE HIGHER THAN THE PRIOR SEASON'S AVERAGE, THE CURRENT AVERAGE MUST BE USED. Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain or others. WHEN USING CURRENT AVERAGE, VERIFICATION FROM YOUR LEAGUE SECRETARY IS REQUIRED.
- 6. A bowler is required to report prize money won in excess of \$300.00 in a single event, in excess of \$500.00 in the combined prize money, and /or in excess of \$1,000.00 in all tournaments competed in within 12 months. Failure to comply is cause for a forfeiture of entry fee and prize winnings. (CTF Rule 319d, also CTF Rule 16a Bowlers Responsibility)
- 7. Tournament management reserves the right to re-rate any entrant prior to bowling. If the entrant refuses the re-rate, entry fees will be refunded. Entrants have the right to appeal any re-rate to the CTF within 15 days of the date of bowling or prior to the payment of prizes, whichever comes first. Any bowler who has been re-rated or has refused a re-rated average in a sanctioned or unsanctioned tournament MUST report same to the tournament manager prior to bowling. (CTF Rule 319c)
- 8. If the bowler's accumulated average for all, but not less than 21 tournament games, exceeds the average to be used for entry by 15 or more pins, the accumulated average MUST be used for handicapping or classification purposes.

 Note: In the application of this rule, sanctioned and unsanctioned tournament scores MUST be reported to the tournament manager. (CTF Rule 319e)
- 9. A tournament game or frame(s) within a game that is irretrievably lost in the scoring process may be rebowled with approval of tournament management, unless prohibited by rule. The decision of tournament management shall be final, except where an appeal is made to CTF for final consideration. (CTF Rule 328)
- 10. When there is a tie for first place, co-champions will be declared. Duplicate awards will be given to the champions.
- 11. Prize money will be returned 100%, prize ratio 1 in 7 or major fraction thereof in each event, and will be mailed to the Team Captains. Team Captains shall distribute prize money within 15 days. Bowlers participating in the 600 Club and/or 700 Club Optional events may cash in all three events. Bowler of the Year points will be awarded for both handicap scores and scratch scores based on ALL entries in the tournament.
- 12. The use of such substances as talcum powder, pumice, rosin, etc., on shoes or the use of soft rubber soles and heels that rub off and in any manner alter the normal conditions of the approach is strictly prohibited. (CTF Rule 12)
- 13. The Tournament Director's decisions in all matters pertaining to the tournament are final.
 - **Dress Code:** Unacceptable attire: tank tops, halter tops, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, jeans that are torn, not clean or in poor condition, no torn tee shirts. Failure to comply will result in your not being able to bowl.
